## Re: Restrictions on Certain ST Technology, Software, and Products to Russia and Belarus

Dear ST Distributor

We would like to remind you that many of the technologies, software and products provided by STMicroelectronics companies ("ST") are currently prohibited from being exported, reexported, or transferred to Russia and Belarus as a result of the economic sanctions and export controls recently imposed by the US, UK, EU, and other nations.

In addition, comprehensive trade restrictions have been imposed on the Ukrainian regions of Donetsk (DPR) and Luhansk (LPR), in addition to the previous restrictions on the Crimea region that have been in place since 2014.

As the exporter or re-exporter of ST products, you must ensure that no ST technology, software or products identified as restricted or prohibited by the <u>US Export Administration Regulations</u> (EAR), the <u>EU</u>, and the laws imposed by other jurisdictions are provided to Russia, Belarus, LPR, DPR, or Crimea, whether directly or indirectly.

In addition, it is your obligation to conduct the necessary due diligence to ensure you are screening your end customers against the BIS Entity List, BIS Military End User/Use List, and other applicable restricted or sanctioned party lists.
